

How to Auto-Translate YouTube Videos

- Step 1: Open the YouTube video on the NoDark website or directly on YouTube.
- Step 2: On the video player, click the **CC (Closed Captions)** button to turn on subtitles.
- Step 3: Next, click the **Settings** icon (the small gear at the bottom-right corner of the video).
- Step 4: In the menu, select **Subtitles/CC**.
- Step 5: Choose **Auto-translate** from the list of options.
- Step 6: Scroll through the available languages and select **English**.
- Step 7: The subtitles will now automatically appear in English while the video plays.

Tip: If subtitles are not showing, make sure the video has captions enabled by the uploader. Auto-translate works by translating existing captions, so if no captions are provided, the feature may not be available.
